

## Dear Parents,

On **Friday, December 7<sup>th</sup>** we are going to transform our field into a Winter Wonderland where our students and teachers can have a fun day playing in the snow! Before all the snow angels and snowmen are made, we will gather each group to take a fun Snow Day group photo. After taking the group photos, the children will have a fun and rare opportunity to play in the snow during their outdoor playtime hour.

**Students who do not attend school on Fridays may be dropped off during their group's outdoor play time** (please make sure your child is at school 10 minutes earlier than their group's scheduled time to ensure they are in the group photo). **Those children who do not attend school on Fridays need to be picked up at the end of their snow day play time.**

This event is for current First Steps students only and **no siblings of any age are allowed to join**. This is done to ensure that all students have the opportunity to enjoy quality and safe play time in the snow. If any parent brings a sibling, they will unfortunately not be allowed to enter the field. As much as we love our alumni and our future students, we need to ensure that our First Steps students are having fun and parents are considerate enough to be on the sidelines and leave the snow for the kids to enjoy. ### Volunteers

If you would like your child to take part in this event and/or you would like to volunteer, please sign and indicate so on the consent form posted next to your child's sign-in/sign-out sheet by Friday, November 30<sup>th</sup>. **Please note that there will be only two volunteer parents per group. To be fair, we will draw names and your child's teacher will notify you by Friday, November 30<sup>th</sup> if you are picked.**

If you are a volunteer parent, no cameras will be allowed since you will be on the snow. All our attention will need to be on the safety of the students. **Any parents who are not picked to be a volunteer but would still like to attend Snow Day may watch, take photos and videos around the snow area.**

### Parking

We ask that you please **park in the Honolulu Ave parking lot** and walk up to the field where the children will be having Snow Day. In order to allow all parents to be with their children during this exciting activity, we ask that parents who want to participate only come during the time that their children will be outside in the snow, and not sooner. We love that so many of our parents want to be involved but we ask that you please **vacate the parking lot right after the event** to allow for other parents to come spend time with their children. Just in case the Honolulu parking lot is full, please consider using the park and ride lot next to the 210 freeway and carpooling to the campus.
